2004 Bremerton Old Adam, Langhorne Creek, AS40
A traditional warm area South Australian shiraz: coconut-laced blackberry jam aromas, with a slicky-soft texture and liberal tannins that fold into the wine well. Generous and with lots of straightforward flavour. **12+**

2004 Step Rd Shiraz, Langhorne Creek, AS20
A good wine of the bigger style: concentrated and fleshy, like reduced stock, with mouth-coating tannins and plenty of structure. Robust and solid, somewhat oak-driven, with lots of hang for modest backs. **15+**

2004 Campbells Bobbie Burns Shiraz, Rutherglen, AS22/NZS36
An ultra-ripe, fruit-driven shiraz with mild oak and soft tannins; a fruitcake note in the bouquet and blackberry jam on the palate. Big and lush - almost opulent. **16**

2004 Creed The Pretty Miss Shiraz Cabernet Franc Viognier, Barossa Valley, AS19
Rather a mouthful to say, and a damn impressive mouthful of wine from a new producer. Pepper, vanilla and jam characters - a complex mixture of flavours. Lots happening and a bit on the wild side, but it will have many fans. **15**

2004 Penfolds Bin 389 Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz, South Australia, AS45/NZS49
Thank heavens for Penfolds, still delivering traditional classic reds. This is dark, deep and solid, with ample, slightly chewy tannins, flesh and density. Rather osky in youth, but with a big future. **2-15+**

2004 Heritage Wines Roscoe's Shiraz, Barossa Valley, AS40
Peppermint aromas are almost mouth-bite in their intensity. This is a very deep and big wine, considerable tannin grip but no astringency. Flecks of vanilla and toasty oak. Needs time. **2-12+**

2004 Penley Estate Special Select Coonawarra Shiraz, AS55/NZS50
This needs time to open up and responds to astring. Vivid purple colour; minty and sable berry aromas starting to mellow, but not yet complex. The palate is rich and essence-like with some alcohol warmth. **10**

2004 Tyrrell's Wines Brokenback Shiraz, Hunter Valley, AS23/NZS25
Some meaty, feral aromas, slightly reductive but complex and alluring. The palate is smooth as satin, fleshy and well balanced, growing spicier as it airs in the glass. A wine for drinking, it's very more-ish. **16+**

2004 Possimus Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, McLaren Vale, AS25/NZS35
Wine scientist John Possingham has made a lovely smooth, fleshy full-bodied red from a good cabernet year in McLaren Vale. Spot-on ripeness, lots of flesh on the bones, soft and supple, drinking well already. **13+**

2002 Clancy Fuller Silesian Barossa Shiraz, AS25
Good colour for a five-year-old, with fruit-driven raspberry aromas and a leaner, more spicy kind of palate with some jammy hints to contrast. Displays a lean and wiry but also quite muscular structure. **13+**
